### **NHS Practice**

I provide the regional tertiary pelvic- acetabular trauma service with a special interest in primary and revision hip and knee joint replacements, long bone and joint articular fractures, and knee arthroscopy. My workload has consisted of specialist lower limb and some general upper limb trauma, periprosthetic fractures around joint replacements, and soft tissue injuries arising from accidents, falls and other mechanisms. I also treat young adults with a variety of different hip and knee problems and such as dysplasia, early arthritis, soft tissue problems, sports related bony injuries, and osteotomy for young adults with dysplastic hips.

### **Medicolegal Practice**

I provide reports on clinical negligence within my specialist area of practice. This includes primary and revision hip and knee replacements, pelvic and acetabular fractures, and long bone and periarticular trauma. I provide reports on personal injuries relating to my trauma practice including those arising from RTA, trips, slips, falls, major trauma, long bone and articular fractures, pelvic fractures, acetabulum fractures, (hip, tibia, ankle, femur, etc), soft tissue neck and back injuries (whiplash), injuries to the knee, ankle & periprosthetic fractures, low velocity impact.
