<p>Correction of typographical errors, and amendments not affecting causation and prognosis</p> <p><i>Scanned copies of contemporaneous handwritten records are retained by me, and I will not add injuries, change length of symptoms, and/or change my prognosis based on comments</i></p>	<p>No Fee</p>
<p>Correspondence</p> <p><i>The fee will depend on the amount of re-reading of material and editing required.</i></p>	<p>£400 per hour</p>
<p>Answers to CPR Part 35 Questions</p> <p><i>The minimum fee is £200</i></p>	<p>£400 per hour</p>
<p>Informal Teleconference to discuss report (up to 15 minutes)</p> <p><i>A fee for professional time, charged at £100 per 15 minute increment will apply for longer conversations</i></p>	<p>No fee</p>
